At the start of each session, the staff will review and grade the students on their journal entries and their ability to explain the completed PEC behaviors. Students must maintain a 3.0 average on weekly assignments. Attendance requirements:

- No more than two unexcused absences
- No more than two 10-minute tardinesses
- More than 10 minutes tardiness equals an absence

Only students who successfully complete Phase 1 (achieve 3.0 average & above and meet attendance requirements) will be invited to participate in Phase 2. This Phase will be held offsite.
